


# LGH User: Logging Attendance and Obtaining Certificates/Transcripts



To log attendance and/or get your certificate and transcript click on **eeds LGH Sign-In**




**Log in** with your LGH Network User ID and password




Once you log into your eeds account via the LGH CME Website you can also:

# eeds: Free iPhone App

1. Go to the App Store on your iPhone
2. Tap the Search icon at the bottom of your screen
3. Search for “eeds”
4. Choose the “eeds mobile” app
5. Download the app (you’ll need your iTunes password)






# iPhone App Continued...

This is the log in that you use for EPIC.




If your User ID is found, you'll be asked to select your last name. Otherwise you'll need to create an account.



# eeds: Free Android App

1. Go to the Google Play Store
2. Search for “eeds”
3. Choose the “eeds mobile” app
4. Tap the **Install** button





(Disregard the mobile number and email address options.)


If your User ID is found, you'll be asked to select your last name. Otherwise, you'll need to create an account.

## How to View CME On Demand




