*IV.D.1. Institutional GME Policies and Procedures: The Sponsoring Institution must have a policy that requires each of its ACGME-accredited programs to determine the criteria for promotion and/or renewal of a resident's/fellow's appointment. (Core)*

<b>To Whom does the policy apply:</b>	All Lancaster General Hospital sponsored ACGME accredited programs
<b>Policy:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.) Each ACGME accredited program will establish criteria for promotion to the next post-graduate level and/or program completion.</li> <li>2.) Program promotion and graduation criteria will be specific to each year, providing the minimum level of performance required to matriculate to the succeeding year, and successfully graduate from the program.</li> <li>3.) The Program Director or designee will develop and review/update the criteria annually, or as needed.</li> <li>4.) Promotion/completion criteria for each year will be made accessible to the resident/fellow at or before the start of the academic year.</li> <li>5.) The faculty advisor will review the criteria and resident/fellow's related progress during semi-annual reviews, or more frequently if needed.</li> </ol>
