Carpool Driver Safety Checklist



BEFORE THE RIDE: Outside the Car

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YES	NO	I have a valid	driver's	license and	carry	auto insurance.

I am aware that there are FREE Car Seat Fitting Stations in Lancaster County where I can learn how to properly secure car seats and booster seats in the car.

YES NO I have not been convicted of a crime against a child.

YES NO I can see each child that I will drive as they approach my car.

YES NO Children not riding in my car are fully supervised and/or physically held by an adult, so I do not back over them by mistake.

DURING THE RIDE: Inside the Car

YES	NO	Each child will ride in a car seat, booster seat or safety belt, based on individual age,
TES I	NO	weight and height.

YES NO Each child has their own safety belt system to hold them, the booster seat or car seat.

YES NO Each child under 13 is riding in a back seat.

YES NO Airbags have been disabled for infants and children who must ride in the front seat (front seat location is NOT recommended.)

YES NO I drive only as many occupants as there are safety belts.

YES NO I have been taught to use the booster seats or car seats correctly for the children in transport, including locking out the seat belt that secures the seats to the vehicle.

YES NO I do not start the car until every person is properly buckled.

YES NO I do not drive children if I have had any alcohol or other drugs that impair.

YES NO There are no weapons in my car.

AFTER THE RIDE: Outside the Car

YES	NO	I make sure that all children exit my car on the curb side.
ILO	140	I make sure that all children exit my car on the curb side.

YES NO Once children exit my car, I wait until they are safely supervised before driving off.

Child Passenger Safety Laws in Pennsylvania

All Drivers are responsible for securing children in the appropriate restraint system.

Children Aged 0-4 years

- All children from birth to age 4 must be secured in an approved car seat anywhere in the vehicle
- Children younger than 2 must be secured in a rear-facing car seat until the child outgrows the maximum weight and height limits of the seat.
- Violators of this primary law are subject to a fine of \$75.00 plus court costs, EMS, Surcharge and administrative fees.

Children Aged 4 to 8 years

- All children 4 years of age and older, but less than 8 years of age, must be secured in a seat belt system and an appropriate beltpositioning booster seat anywhere in the vehicle.
- Violators of this primary law are subject to a fine of \$75.00 plus court costs, EMS, Surcharge and administrative fees.

Children Aged 8 to 18 years

- All children 8 years of age and older, but less than 18 years of age, must be secured in a seat belt system anywhere in the vehicle.
- Violators of this primary law are subject to a fine of \$10.00 plus EMS, Surcharge and administrative fees.
